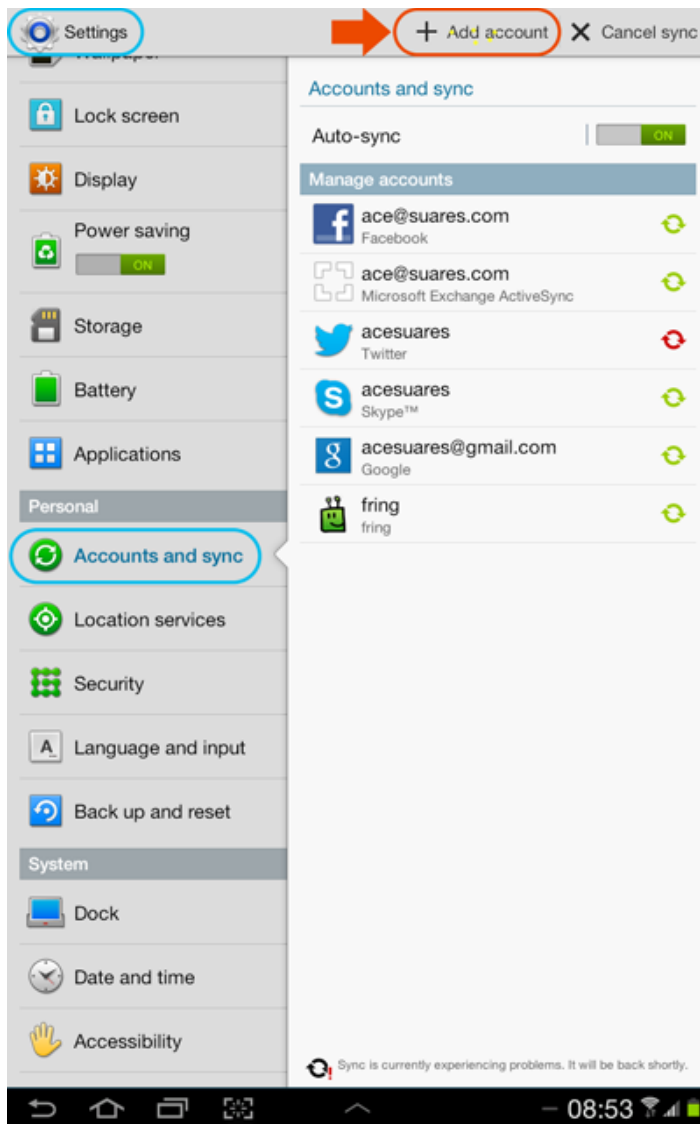


Mail settings for smartphone or tablet

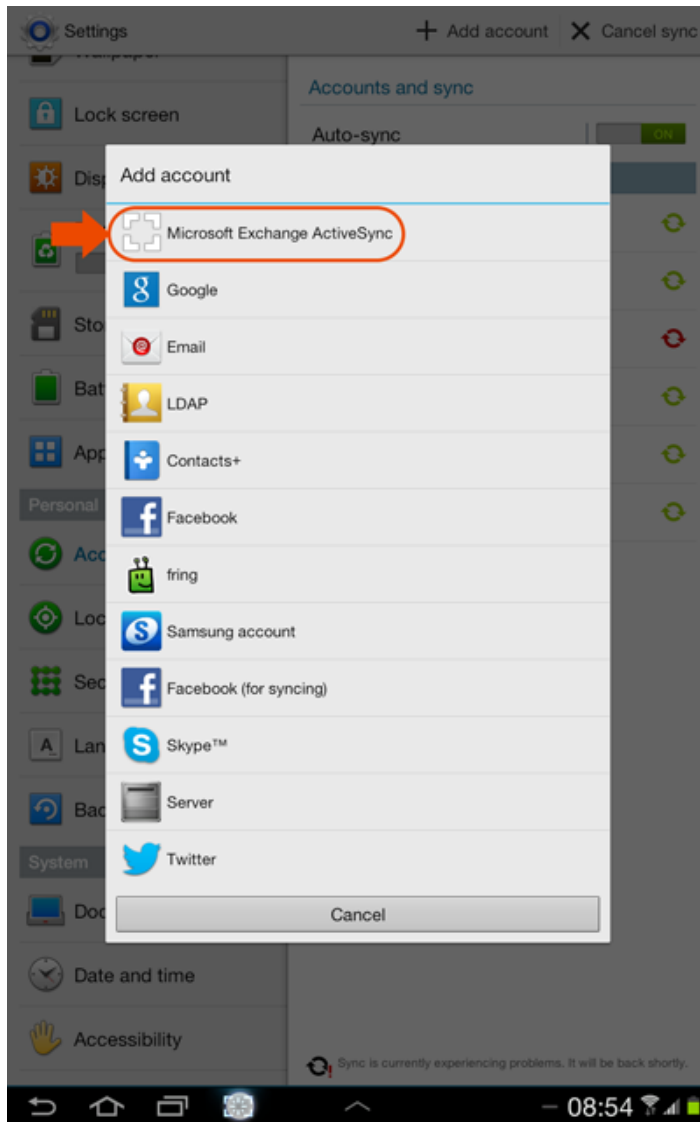
The images that follow illustrate step by step how to set up your mail account on a Samsung tablet. For an Ipad or other smartphone the settings are the same. The steps can vary a little though.

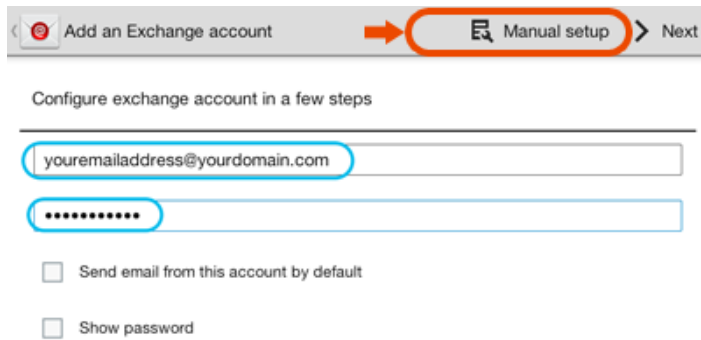


Go to Settings > Accounts and sync.

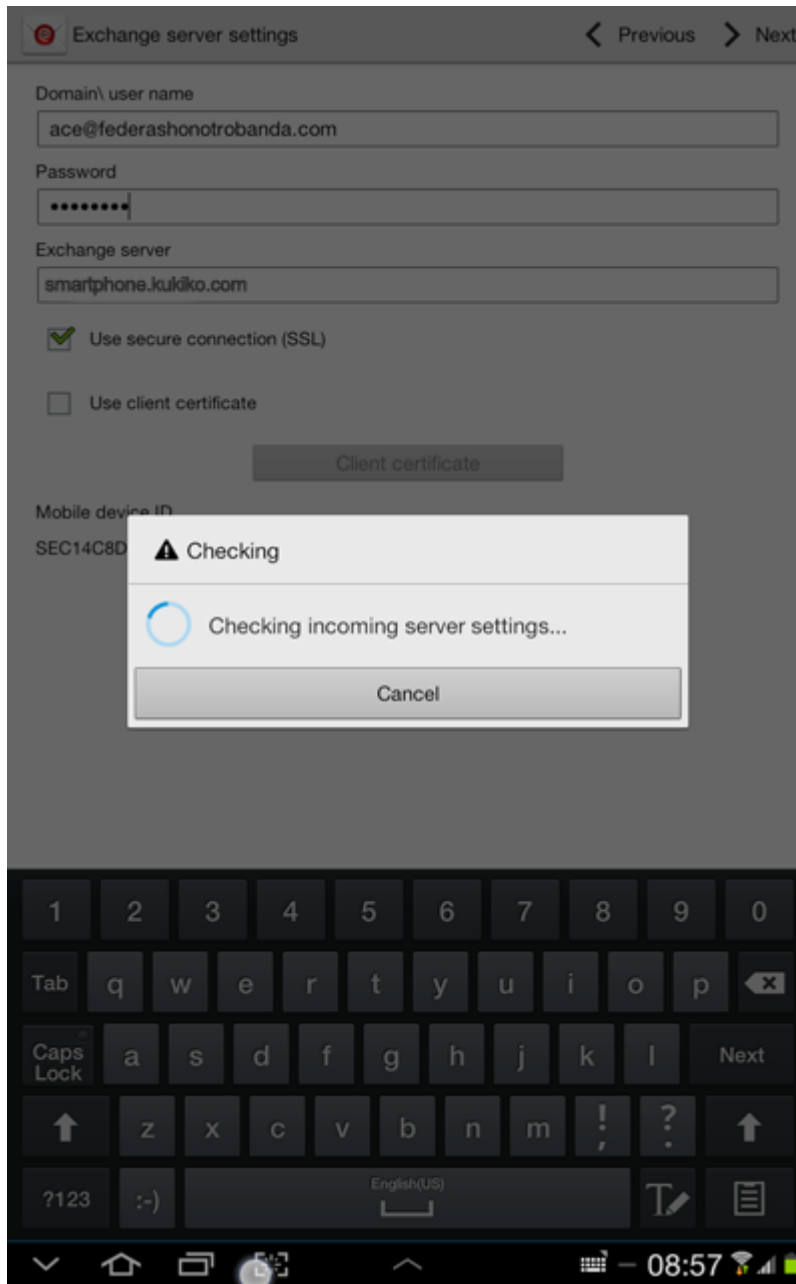

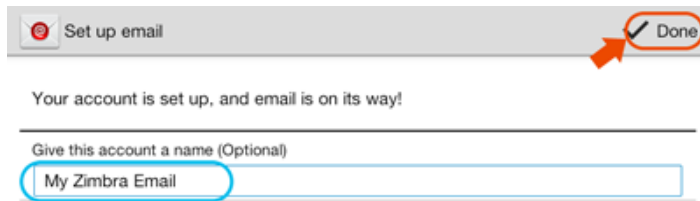

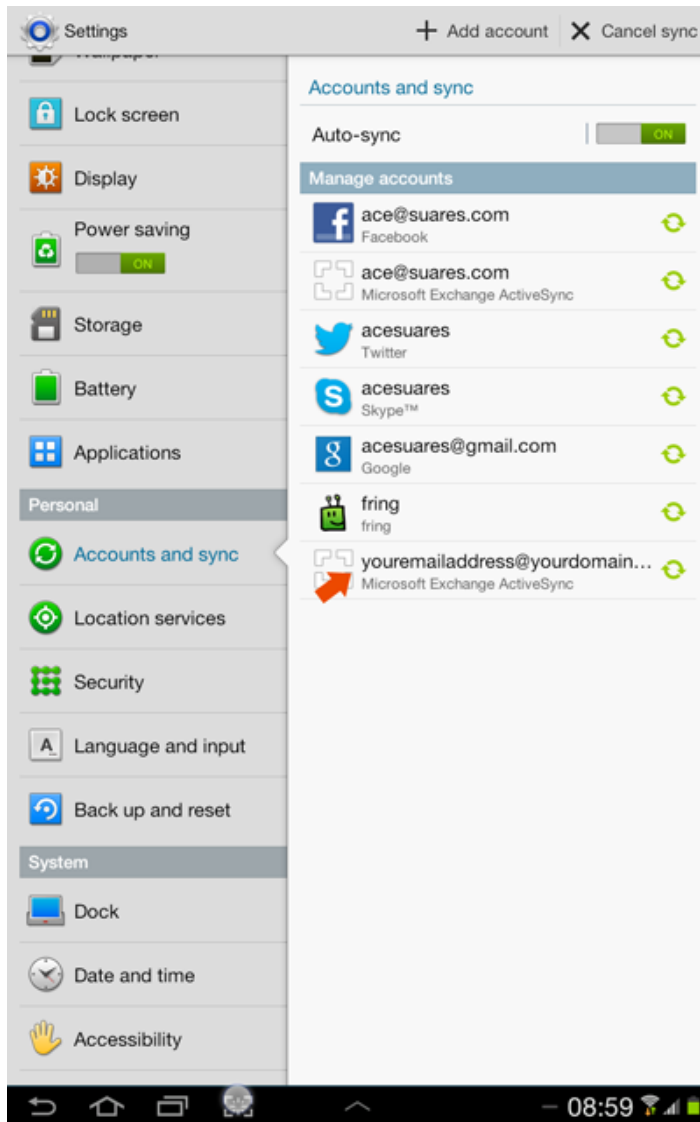
